Instructions on using MySmart123 Portable Maths Classroom

Please take note of the following points.

1. If you want to run MySmart123 Portable Maths Classroom on your tablet or mobile phone which runs on iOS 5.0, Android 4.0 or a more recent operating system, please keep MySmart123 (at the following website address: www.MySmart123.com/123practice) as a bookmark.
2. If you use a desktop computer, you have to take notice of the following requirement of the browser being used:
Students are recommended to use Chrome or Microsoft Edge of the latest version so that the platform can be used in a more stable and smoother manner.

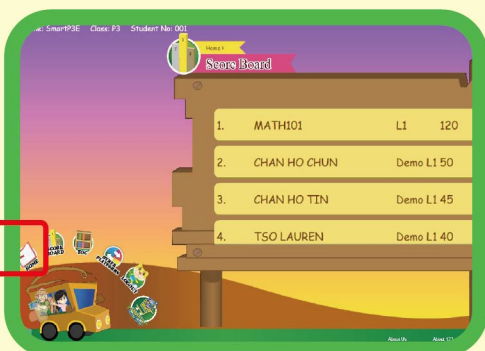
Logging into the Platform and Start Doing Exercises


Students can click on the 'MySmart123 Portable Maths Classroom' link on their school's website or type "www.MySmart123.com/123practice" directly into the address bar of the browser.

Log in to the system

Once students are taken to the page shown in the screen capture on the left, students can enter their personal login ID in the blank space of "Login Account" and personal password in the blank space of "Password". Students can then click the button of "Login", which will immediately let them log in to MySmart123 Portable Maths Classroom.

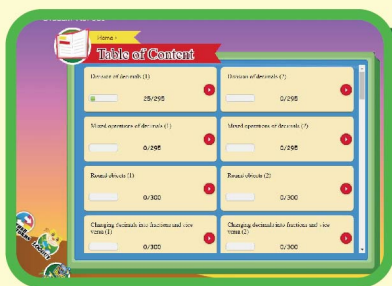

After logging into the platform successfully, students can click the button of "Table of Contents"  on the bottom left corner to view different modules,

in which students can click to find daily exercises they are required to complete every day. Modules and exercises will be updated on a regular basis.

Everyday Learning Procedures



Step 1: On the page of "Table of Contents", students click the ungraded weekly exercises, and will be taken to the page of the corresponding module. We have arranged appropriate learning content for students according to students' learning levels to ensure that the exercises cater for the needs of different students.

★ Printing out worksheets

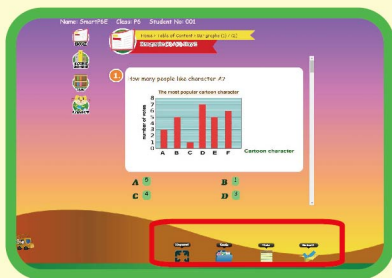
Students click the "tools" button and choose  , then they can print out the relevant exercises.

They can save the notes by clicking the "Save" button.

After completing all questions in the exercise, students can submit the exercise by clicking the  button.



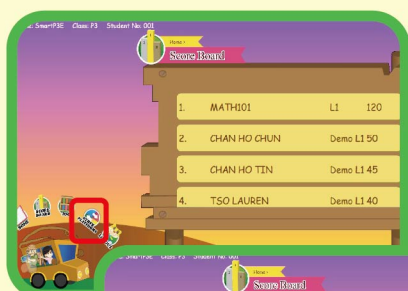
My Performance Report
